Local Government Official Information Request –CCTV and Ōmokoroa Structure Plan

I refer to your official information request received by Western Bay of Plenty District Council (Council) on 28 June 2023 where you have requested information pertaining to CCTV and the Ōmokoroa Structure Plan.

The answers to your questions are set out below:

1. How many CCTV cameras do we have in Ōmokoroa? Where are they? How are they monitored?

2. Structure plan stage 3 in Ōmokoroa: Where are we at with this structure plan?

The structure plan for stage 3 in Ōmokoroa was notified on 20 August 2022 as part of Plan Change 92 – Ōmokoroa and Te Puke Enabling Housing Supply and Other Matters.

We received submissions on the plan change including specific submissions to the structure plan itself. Staff are currently working on planner reports that will be presented at a hearing which is expected to occur in September this year. Changes to the Structure Plan in response to submissions are likely to be presented as part of that process. We are aiming to have a decision on the plan change by December this year. The plan change including the Structure Plan for Stage 3 will become operative at that point.
